	Substance use and mental disorders prevention and treatment, especially if required for postpartum depression <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Substance use disorder treatment, including medication-assisted treatment</li> <li>• Care for co-occurring mental health conditions, particularly maternal depression</li> <li>• Substance use disorder care management to enhance treatment access and retention via outreach services and ongoing recovery supports</li> <li>• Designated treatment provider who is, to the extent possible, knowledgeable about child welfare, delivers gender-specific programming, is family focused, is trauma informed and provides trauma-specific treatment</li> <li>• Mental health services, including for symptoms of depression and anxiety and trauma-specific treatment</li> <li>• Substance use and mental health treatment for other family members or caregivers</li> </ul>

	<p>physical effects or withdrawal symptoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coordinated care management for parents and family in conjunction with the child welfare and other partners</li> <li>• Follow-up services, such as infant care, parent/infant bonding support, nurturing parenting coaching and skill development, safe sleep practice support and parental support with appropriate intensity based on individual family needs through such methods as on-site education, classes and short-term in-home and longer-term home visits</li> <li>• Education on potential county children and youth agency involvement and Plans of Safe Care</li> <li>• Evidence-based home visiting services and parent-child therapy</li> <li>• Interventions for intimate partner and family violence</li> <li>• Child care in developmentally appropriate setting</li> <li>• Education/employment support</li> <li>• Safety net benefits eligibility determination</li> <li>• Recovery support, including safe and stable housing and transportation assistance</li> <li>• Life/social Skills</li> <li>• Assistance with legal status</li> </ul>
